PERENNIAL WOOD™ FACTORY FINISHED DECKING

Perennial Wood decking is factory finished with a semitransparent, water-based finish system. Its unique, proprietary waterborne formulation is specifically designed for long-term durability. This is achieved through a combination of performance characteristics that centers on good adhesion and flexibility in the coating for better durability. Accordingly, each component of the decking offering is backed by a two-year limited warranty against blistering and peeling of the factory-applied finish. Perennial Wood deck finish is factory applied as an added convenience for customers, eliminating time-consuming work after installation. Additionally, manufacturing standards are set to ensure that each piece is uniformly coated in a multistep process to obtain consistent color tones and preserve the wood's natural character. With Perennial Wood color-matched touch-up pens, you no longer need an entire quart of Perennial Wood deck finish for minor scratches and blemishes. For end cuts, a quart of stain is still required, but for small nick and scratches, these touch-up pens will save time, reduce messes and help keep decks looking their best. They are currently available at no charge to homeowners who complete the form under "Contact Us" at PerennialWood.com.

Although Perennial Wood deck finish provides resistance to scratching and staining after installation, it is not an impermeable surface. Like virtually any material, it can be damaged in transit, in storage, or on the jobsite. Perennial Wood decking is packaged to protect against potential minor mishaps. For best results, the packaging should remain intact until the product is ready to be installed. All decking components should be stored in a cool, dry, covered place to protect the finish from incidental damage. Perennial Wood decking components should not be stacked directly on top of each other without foam packaging in between as the coating can block or stick, damaging the finish.

To remove leaves or debris from your Perennial Wood deck, sweep with a soft-bristle broom or spray with a water hose. When necessary, use a neutral pH cleaner, or a small amount of mild powdered laundry detergent, or a dishwashing detergent in water to help clean surface dirt. Be sure to rinse thoroughly and allow to dry naturally. Perennial Wood deck finish is resistant to most common stains. For best results, attempt cleaning within the first 24 hours of the blemish. The factory-applied deck finish on Perennial Wood decking has a two-year limited residential warranty against peeling and blistering. (This warranty of the finish is separate from the 25-year limited residential warranty against rot, decay, and movement on Perennial Wood.) The warranty is only applicable when the finish is factory-applied to Perennial Wood decking products. Refer to PerennialWood.com for full warranty details and conditions.
